

How does the contest work?

The concept is simple – use PEEPS, the delicious sugary marshmallow treats, to create a sculpture, mosaic, diorama, or other type of visual art. PEEPS do not have to be the main component of the piece, but they should be the focus. Maybe it's the reenactment of an historical event, an image of a tabloid pop star, or perhaps a replica of a famous piece of art – the options are endless!

When are contest entries due?

Bring your marshmallow masterpiece to Magnolias of Chambersburg by Monday March 19—Saturday March 23, between 10am-4pm, no later than Friday March 22, along with your \$5 contest entry fee and the form below. Winners will be announced at our Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday March 23rd (winners need not be present to win). Easter Egg Hunt Attendees will vote for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners, granting the "Peeples Choice Awards." Along with awards, winners will be featured on the Magnolias of Chambersburg's social media pages.

What is the cost?

There is a \$5 fee per contest entry. There is **no** admission fee to view the exhibit or attend the **Easter Egg Hunt!** All proceeds will benefit the Alzheimer's Association. Cash payment please.
